Great Drinks for Thanksgiving

It is November and I am sure everyone has plans in full effect for the holidays already. This month will bring Thanksgiving, friends, family and many different reasons for maybe trying some new products. These products will help keep you warm and are great sippers.

First one I would like to tell you about is Forbidden Secret Dark Mocha. This is a Tennessee whiskey based cream liqueur. The packaging itself is really appealing. It has a great mix of flavoring; dark chocolate, rich robust espresso, great American cream. It also has a blend of dark mocha. It has some similarities of Baileys. I would strongly recommend trying this at least once and I bet you will be hooked. Drink this in either coffee, on the rocks or in a cocktail.

Forbidden Fantasy

2 oz. Forbidden Secret

1 oz. Vodka

½ oz. half and half or ice cream

Mix Forbidden Secret and vodka in shaker.

Float ice cream or half and half

Kahlua is one of those well know names and they have just released a new seasonal flavor. The new flavor is Kahlua Gingerbread, and of course they have re-released Kahlua Peppermint Mocha again this season. Kahlua Gingerbread is a balanced mixture of gingerbread, nutmeg, subtle cinnamon and clove. Don't worry though the mixture doesn't lose the Arabian coffee or slight rum flavor. The Kahlua

Peppermint Mocha is a blend of dark chocolate and peppermint flavor. They are both considered limited release, while supplies last. If you enjoy them I suggest getting a couple bottles before they go. Both of these Kahlua can be drank on the rocks or in festive cocktails.

The Cookie Martini

1 ½ parts Kahlua Gingerbread

1 ½ parts Vodka

Combine ingredients in shaker. Add ice and shake. Pour into chilled martini glass. Garnish with cinnamon stick and enjoy.

Kahlua Mint Chocolate Celebration

1 part Kahlua Peppermint Mocha

2 part Hot Chocolate

*Combine ingredients in mug and stir.
Garnish with mint leaf and enjoy.*

It is also the time of the year that Pennsylvania Dutch Egg Nog comes out. I have heard many good things about this product throughout the years. It is a pre-made egg nog. It is a blend of whiskey, brandy and rum which is mixed with the fresh holiday favorite. This is a seasonal item as well so it is while supplies last. This is meant to be drank on the rocks and sipped.

Pennsylvania Dutch also has pumpkin cream liquor. This is a really great thing to have for a family gathering, everyone is sure to be a fan. It is made with fresh dairy cream and has a great pumpkin flavoring. Drink this one on the rocks as well. I would suggest it for after dinner.

Ricacha Horchata Cream Liqueur is a new cream that just hit the stores. If the Horchata cream looks familiar for some reason I am sure most of you have either heard of or at least tried Rum Chata before. They are both rum based and actually similar in flavor. I myself was really surprised when I got to try the Ricacha. It has all the similar qualities of Rum Chata. It has a sweet vanilla and cinnamon taste. It is slightly cheaper than Rum Chata as well. I think if you like vanilla and cinnamon you would really love this liqueur. I would suggest drinking this on the rocks with a little ice to keep it cool.

As everyone is hanging around the kitchen table or maybe around the living room, bring out one of these liqueurs and I am positive you will have a hit. These are all wonderful to have especially now that it's getting a little colder out. They are delicious, as well as guaranteed to keep you a little warmer.
